leather lacing techniques pdf file - Braiding

Pull any slack out of the first loop and adjust lacing with fingers to make all stitches appear equal. Push stylus tip of slit and up between leathers. modeling tool down between leathers and hook it over end of the lace. Pull end of lace out of Two empty slits should appear on the front side; one on the back.

Sewing and braiding Made from sheet brass, these conical tips were sewn to the ends of ribbons, braids, cords, and leather laces, to make it easy to thread them through small round lacing holes in clothing. Women's bodices were fastened by lacing, and sleeves were laced to bodices. Men's hose and breeches were laced to jerkins and doublets, and

Eight-String Round Edge Leather Braid, Part 1. For clarity through hole 6 And then for clarity the two strings ready to head back to the right. At this point go back to the beginning holes and begin a back lace. Move the lacing needles to the tag ends and again follow the pattern.

Eight-String Round Edge Leather Braid, Part 1 - Old Jimbo

If you use lacing or a strip of leather here, you need to sew together or glue down the ends of the lacing. It can look a bit more professional, however, to cap the ends of the braid with a larger piece of leather. You can do this with a two piece cap if you want to create a shaped end, or one piece folded over to create a flat end.

Leather Lacing Tips & Tricks. By using scrap leather and the Craftool Lace Maker, you can cut your own lace from a circle or square of scrap leather! The Single Loop stitch is best suited for lacing the edges of lightweight leathers or single thickness of leather, as little lace is required to cover the raw edge. This is great for projects like a key fob or small coin purse.

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Repeat steps 4-6 for braiding the individual strands. Make sure you pass the lower end of the strip through strands 2 and 3 to complete the braiding cycle, as demonstrated in step 7. If you opted to braid a 9 inch x 3 inch leather strip, you should be done braiding after 2 cycles total.
