Historically, the expansion of adult-derived cells from these organs in vitro has proven challenging and this in turn has hampered studies of liver and pancreas stem cell biology, as well as being a roadblock to disease modelling and cell replacement therapies for pathologies in these organs.

Blood Glucose Homeostasis Glucose is the transport carbohydrate in animals, and its concentration in the blood affects every cell in the body. Its concentration is therefore strictly controlled within the range 0.8 – 1g per dm³ of blood, and very low levels (hypoglycaemia) or very high levels (hyperglycaemia) are both serious and can lead to death.
