Change the Default PDF Viewer in Mac OS X. This works the same to set Preview as the default pdf viewer in all versions of Mac OS: From the Mac OS X desktop or Finder, find a PDF file and hit Command+i to “Get Info” on the file

Set the Default PDF Viewer in Mac OS X Back to Preview

Mac OS X and PDF. OS X is the first operating system on the market that actually uses PDF technology within the operating system itself. Apple calls this technology ‘Quartz’. Quartz is a layer of software that runs on top of Darwin, the core (or kernel) of the Mac OS X operating system. It is responsible for the rendering of all 2D objects.

Using Mac OS X Periodically, Apple releases updates to Mac OS X and other software. If you can’t quit an application, choose Force Quit from the Apple menu, Software Update is set up to check for updates automatically once a select the application in the list, and click Force Quit.
